Brief description of project: This component of the larger SWSC Water System Improvement effort involves replacing aging distribution lines in the 5 Mile area between Conway Ave. and Taylor Rd. The goal is to improve distribution capacity for continuous development / growth, system efficiency, reduce service disruptions, and ensure continued delivery of safe drinking water.

Brief listing of water quality benefits: The improvements will lead to more consistent water pressure and greater system reliability for residents in the area. By replacing deteriorating lines, we expect a reduction in leaks and unplanned service outages. These upgrades will also help lower long-term maintenance and operating costs. In addition, they support the broader goal of protecting local water resources and enhancing environmental health across the community.
