

PUBLIC ADVERTISEMENT / INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sharyland Water Supply Corporation (SWSC) will receive sealed bids for the Water Treatment Plant 1 (WTP 1) Reservoir Berm Relocation Project until 11:00 a.m., on the 30th day of March 2023, at the Administration Building located at 321 S. Shary Blvd, Alton, Texas 78573. Bids received after the closing time will be returned unopened. A non-mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be conducted at 2:00 p.m., on the 15 th day of March 2023, at the Administration Building located at 321 S. Shary Blvd, Alton, Texas, 78573. A tour of the reservoir will be held after the meeting. Each bidder shall be limited to three personnel per organization.

Bids shall be accompanied by a bid security in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. The successful Bidder must furnish Performance and Payment Bonds in accordance with the Contract Documents. Bids will be received for a single prime contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis with additive alternate bid items as indicated in the Bid Form.

Davis Bacon Act wage rules shall apply. All laborers and mechanics employed by contractors and subcontractors on projects funded directly by or assisted in whole or in part by and through the Federal Government shall be paid wages at rates not less than those prevailing on projects of a character similar in the locality as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with subchapter IV of Chapter 31 of Title 40, United States Code. The Department of Labor provides all pertinent information related to compliance with labor standards, including prevailing wage rates and instructions for reporting. The project will consist of the following:

Improvements consist primarily of relocating the northern reservoir berm southward, outside of The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT's) future Right of Way, along Mile 5 (FM 676), and increasing the depth of the reservoir to match the existing reservoir capacity. The reservoir improvements also include constructing a concrete liner along the entire embankment perimeter, installing 24-inch diameter raw waterlines and associated structures within the project limits.

Bids must remain in effect for 60 days after the bid opening date. Within 60 days from the bid date, SWSC may award the contract to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder or reject any or all bids for the project.
